30 hours free childcare

30 hours free childcare gives you up to 1,140 hours a year for your 3 or 4 year old. You can choose how you use those hours. If your application is successful, we will send you an eligibility code to give to your childcare provider to secure your child's place. You get the free hours when the next term starts. The free hours stop when your child starts in reception class (or reaches compulsory school age, if later).

Tax-Free Childcare

Tax-Free Childcare gives you up to £500 every 3 months (£2,000 a year) to help with childcare costs for each child under 12. You get a £2 government top-up for every £8 you pay your childcare provider through an online account that we set up if your application is successful.
